
## HELLO FROM RBHS!

# THE DIRECTOR'S DISH

Wow, what a year 2025 has been!! Our shelter saw an increased need for our services from boarding and grooming to also individuals needing to surrender their pets to the shelter. The amount of pregnant cats that gave birth here too was one of the highest in the 4 years I have served as shelter manager. We had 430 dogs & cats enter our shelter needing food, housing and basic veterinary care. 272 of those animals were adopted into

amazing new homes and we were listed as a No-Kill animal shelter due to our efforts placing animals into foster homes and getting them reclaimed by their owners. In 2026 we hope to initiate new programs working with our community and providing more assistance when needed as well as growing our current services. Stay tuned this year to follow our mission and maybe fall in love with a new best friend!

# ADOPTABLE AVENUE

If you have been dreaming of adding a new pet to your family, let us help you find your match! Here on "Adoptable Avenue", we'll highlight some of our residents hoping to make that connection with you.

A few important things to know when adopting from River Bluff Humane Society.

1. All adoptions are scheduled via appointment after your application has been approved.
2. Your current pets MUST be spayed or neutered and have vet history of Distemper & Rabies vaccinations.
3. Landlords must approve of keeping pets on the premise. They will be contacted by RBHS.
4. Apply online at [www.rbhspets.org](http://www.rbhspets.org). Applications are user friendly and on average, take 24-48 to process.
5. Apply today!! You can submit an application even if you don't have a specific animal in mind.

**PAPER APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE AT THE SHELTER**

Gypsy is a 4.5 year old spayed female, German Shepherd. She can be a bit shy at first, but is a lovely dog that knows some basic commands and enjoys playing with other dogs in the yard. She has lived with children and would be an amazing family pet for years to come! **Adoption fee: \$400.00 + tax**

Squeakers is a 3.5 year old spayed female, Heeler mix. A wiggly and loving dog, Squeakers would be excellent with older children who could take her for walks and toss her some toys in the yard. A giant lapdog, be prepared for love and kisses with this one. **Adoption fee: \$350.00 + tax**

Destiny is a 3.5 year old spayed female, Pitbull mix. A good dog with a love for frisbees and chasing balls in the yard. She is a dog that requires a home as the only pet. She tends to want to be the boss with other dogs and doesn't play well with cats so her dream home is a place where she can be the queen. **Adoption fee: \$250.00 + tax**

## BOARDING & GROOMING

### Boarding (All pets must be current on vaccinations!)

Single dog: \$25/day

2 dogs/1 kennel: \$30/day\*

Single cat: \$15/day

\*dogs over 30 pounds require separate kennels

### Grooming We now require proof that the animal is up to date on their Rabies vaccination!

Nail trims (for Cats & dogs): \$17.00 + tax

Baths (No double coated breeds)

- Small breeds (under 15 pounds): \$35.00 + tax
- Medium breeds (16-49 pounds): \$45.00 + tax
- Large breeds (50-80 pounds): \$55.00 + tax
- Extra large breeds (81+ pounds): \$65.00 + tax
